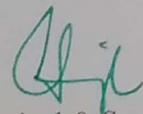

4.1	Statement of Expenditure for Autonomy Grant 2021 – 2022	An Advance of Rs 22 lakhs was received from the management account and spent. A total of Rs. 21,40,667.00 has been spent. This will be transferred back to the Management account once the UGC refunds the funds. The college has completed the mandatory UGC Autonomy Review Committee Visit last month. The report has been filed in New Delhi and awaits the Standing committee meeting. We have been informed we would receive the response within 20 days (by the end of May 2022). Once the letter for Extension of Autonomous Status is through, we hope to receive the outstanding funds via SERO.	Placed on record
4.2	Statement of expenditure of UGC - supported Centre for Women's Studies for the year 2021 - 2022	In the last Board meeting it was approved to spend on the Centre for Women's Studies an amount of Rs. 8,00,000.00 per year, irrespective of whether the UGC sanctions the funds or not. The money was released in November 2021. The CWS has spent Rs. 2,34,012.00 in the last year.	Placed on record

4.3 d.	UGC sanctioned funds for CWS	The Centre for Women's studies in Lady Doak College is eligible for Rs. 8 Lakh per year as a phase two programme. Further sanction by the UGC, under the Women's Studies scheme for 2019 – 2020 & 01.04.2020 to 30.09.2020 (Rs. 8 Lakhs) is awaited.	Placed on record
4.3 e	Settlement of Accounts: Grants under CPE Scheme	The CPE scheme was for the year 2014 -2019. The UGC letters point out two points of change: 1. The college had spent the non-recurring funds in 18 months instead of the required 12 months. But the amount was spent and due to internal miscommunication slotted under a different head. 2. The college had returned some money as a cheque which the UGC failed to encash in the given time. The UGC returned the cheque and requested that the college transfer the funds via RTGS. This has been done and a bank statement to show the same has been got. These documents have been sent repeatedly to the UGC, yet the college receives letters asking the college to settle the matter. On enquiry the UGC section clerk suggested that if the UC be changed the problem would be resolved. But as the accounts have been audited no change can be made in them now.	The College is to write to the UGC, explain that the statements have been audited and therefore cannot be changed and also explain that the requested funds have been transferred via RTGS. The UGC is to be requested to close the account.
4.4	Scholarships given by the Management 2021 – 2022	The Management has sponsored Rs. 98,38,233.00 as scholarship and 326 students benefited from it. The Sports scholarships include hostel fees and college fees for talented students who come from an economically challenged	Placed on record.

4.5	Donations / contributions from Faculty, Alumnae and others (2021-2022)	A total of Rs. 29,88,391.00 has been contributed mainly towards student scholarships. A total of 100 students benefited from these funds this last year.	Placed on record.
4.6	Expenditure on infrastructure by the management from 1 st April 2021 to 30 th April 2022	The management of Lady Doak College has sanctioned and spent Rs. 1,56,89,303.00 on Infrastructure in the last year.	Placed on record.
