Teachers' Day Celebration:

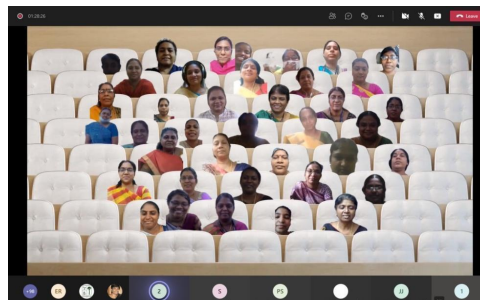
Date: September 7th, 2021

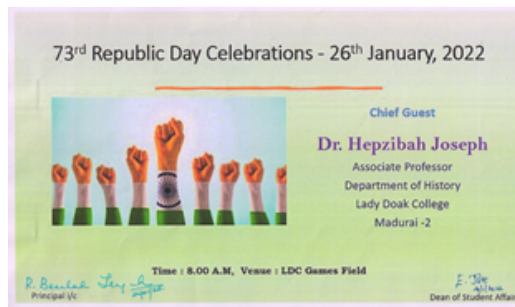
