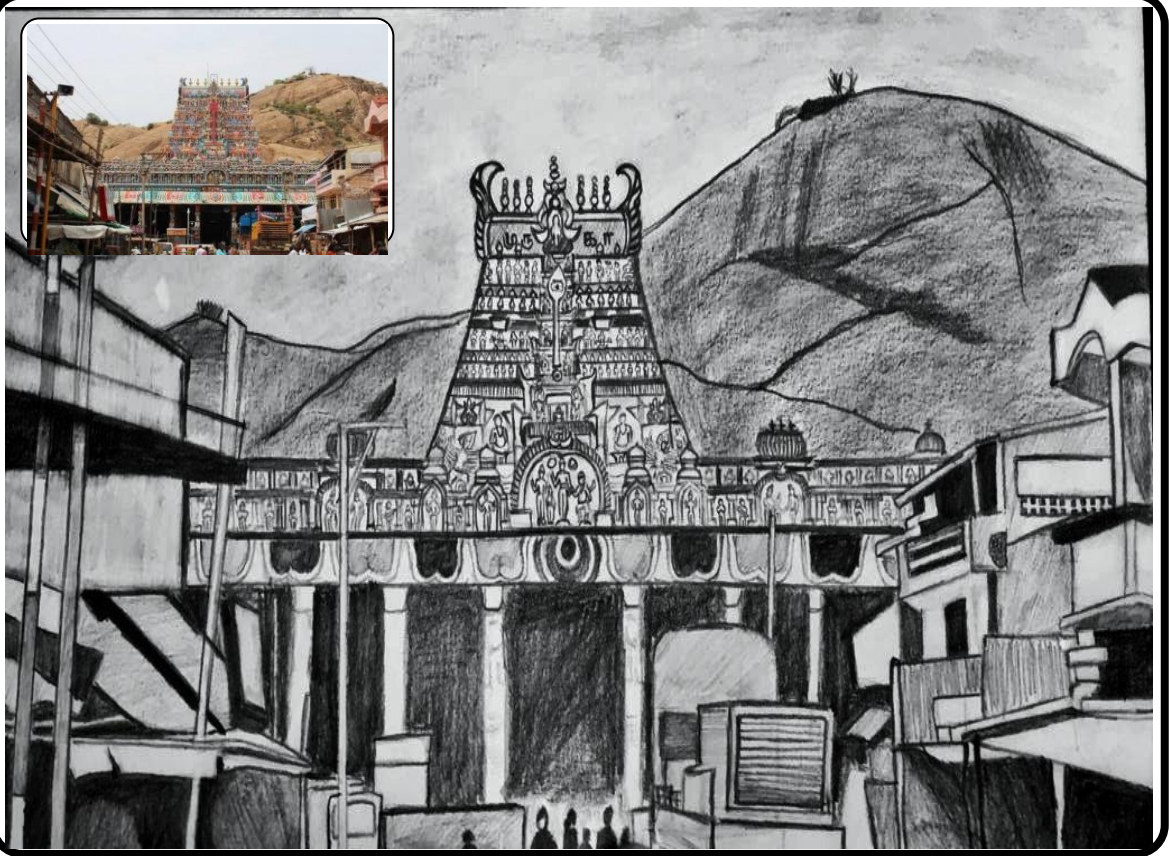


## JAIN PANEL

An early Pandyas rock hewn temple of 8<sup>th</sup> Century AD is a Jain and Hindu pilgrimage center. This was originally a Jain monument but later converted to Saivism site and named after the king as Sundara Pandian Eswaran temple by Prasanna Deva.
