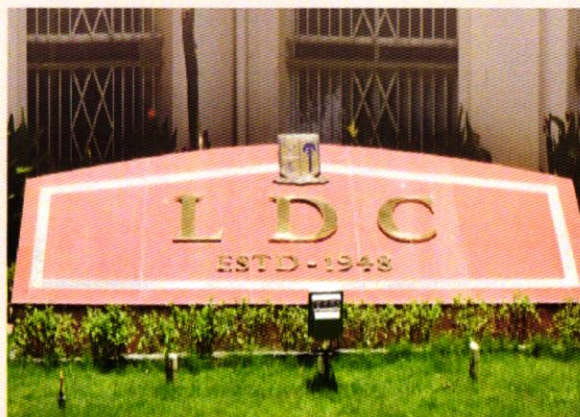

About the Department :

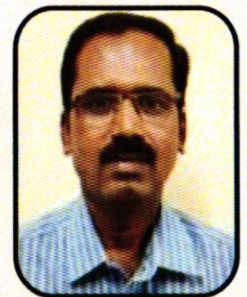

REPORT ON WORKSHOP ON MANUSCRIPT WRITING HELD ON 14/3/23

Dr A Mahalingam, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Medieval History, School of Historical Studies, Madurai Kamaraj University was the Resource Person for the workshop on Manuscript Writing jointly organized by IQAC, Research Development Cell and the PG & Research Department of History. The workshop was held at the Oval Hall from 1.30PM -4.00 PM on 14.3.23. The prayer was led by Dr J Jeyamathy, Assistant Professor, PG & Research Department of History, Lady Doak College, Madurai. The Head of the department Dr Lily Balasingh, Associate Professor, PG & Research Department of History, Lady Doak College, Madurai introduced the resource person and welcomed the gathering.

The first session saw the resource person elaborating on historiographical methods starting with synthetic operations -determining, grouping of facts in research. The critical evaluation of contribution of scholars to the field of historical study was done alongside an overview of the development of historical writing. 'The cut and paste history should be replaced with the philosophy of truth' remarked Dr Mahalingam. The resource person elaborated on types of research writing in history, veracity of sources, prerequisites of a good researcher, bibliography preparation, the linguistic usages of word, heuristics and hermeneutics. Dr A Mahalingam answered queries from the faculty. Dr Durga Devi enquired about the role of imagination in fabricating history pertaining to her research work.

SESSION II was on the research grant organizations and proposal writing. The ICHR's various grants including contingency grant, foreign travel grant, faculty doctoral and postdoctoral grants were elaborated. Grants to attend seminar, conferences and senior academic fellowship were discussed. The ICSSR specific category fellowships, senior fellowships were discussed alongside UGC JRF, Kothari fellowship, single girl child fellowship, fellowship for superannuated faculty members. The Central Institute of Classical Tamil (CICT) has options for doctoral fellowship post doctoral fellowships. Indo -Sri lankan fellowships and scholarships are offered by the Ministry of
