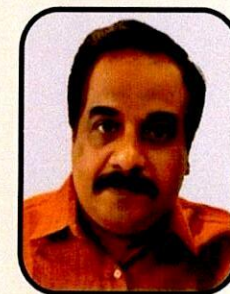

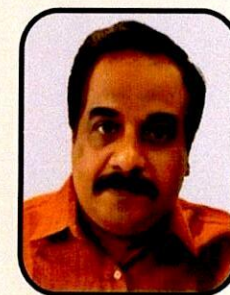

The program started with a prayer by Dr. K. Suganya. Dr. Helen Mary Jacqueline, welcomed the gathering and introduced the resource person. The resource person asked, "Why are we writing a manuscript?" to open the session. He emphasised the value of adding new knowledge to the literature review in his answer. He added that, the manuscript can be started with the context of the paper or how the particular research work is deviated from the previous work. The work should be communicative to the focused group of readers. The session was interactive through raising questions by the participants. The resource person clarified doubts raised by the participants by quoting his experiences in publication. He recommended the researchers to make few academicians to read the draft of the paper and get the appropriate comments to improve the paper. He motivated the participants by not to worry about the rejection of the paper. Adding the comments given by the anonymous reviewers, the paper shall be sent for standard journals for publication. While selecting a journal for publication, the researcher should read few research papers published in that particular journal for identifying to determine the style of those studies. He advised adhering to all journal criteria, including the referencing style. Mrs. Janaki Ganapathy proposed the vote of thanks for the session.
