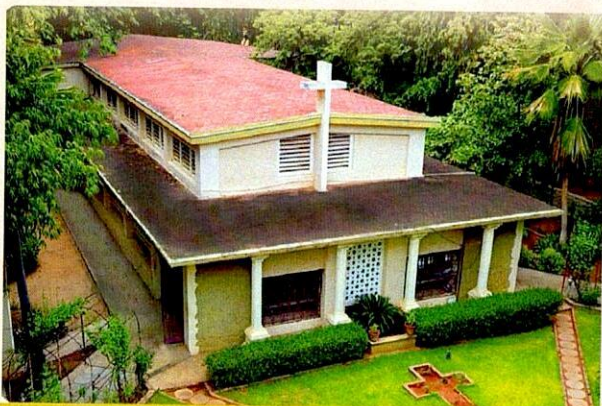

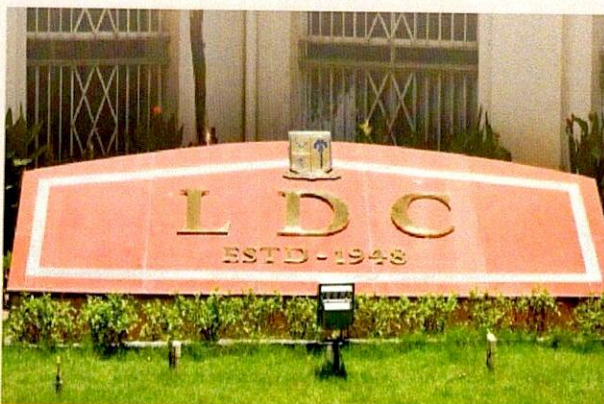

Report on Effective Manuscript Writing

23.02.2023

The Department of Mathematics, Research and Development Cell, and IQAC, Lady Doak College jointly organized a Workshop on Effective Manuscript on 23rd February 2023 to provide tips on writing better research papers and finding the best journals to publish papers in different fields. Faculty and Postgraduate students of the Maths Department attended the programme.

During her opening remarks, Dr. Nirmala Rebecca Paul, Head of the Department of Mathematics, welcomed the chief guest and the gathering. She introduced the resource person Dr. Sophia Porchelvi, Associate Professor of Mathematics at A.D.M. College for Women, Nagapattinam. Participants included 62 undergraduates, 45 postgraduates, and 17 faculty members.

Dr. Sophia Porchelvi delivered the Manuscript Writing lecture, which was well received by all participants. The session sparked lively debates among participants and students about paper publication and project grant funding.
